- Simplify access to data

Progress

- Anchorage was selected for the Bloomberg Philanthropies What Works Cities initiative
 - whatworkscities.bloomberg.org
- Mayor Berkowitz enacted an open data policy on April 27th that makes government data "open by default"
- Launched <u>analytics.muni.org</u> on April 29th
- The administration hired Brendan Babb in May to serve as the Chief Innovation Officer
- Launched Yelp LIVES restaurant inspection data on June 20th
- Launched #ANCWorks! on June 22nd



Web Analytics

- We wanted to open the data we are collecting with Google Analytics to the public
- Code for Anchorage introduced us to the open source project created by 18F for publishing federal government web analytics
- We forked 18F's project to create <u>analytics.muni.org</u>
 - Analytics data is updated on the web site in near real time
 - All analytics data behind the web site are available to the public in CSV or JSON formats



- Open data standard for publishing restaurant inspection information
 - www.yelp.com/healthscores
- Inspection data has historically been available to the public at hhs.muni.org/fss/, but Yelp makes the data more accessible
- Full inspection data sets, including historical data, are planned for publishing using the LIVES Flattened Schema

- This week we finalized an agreement with Socrata to host Anchorage's open data portal
 - socrata.com
- Provide easy to use data analytics and mapping tools for citizens
- Publish data in machine-readable formats
- Provide an API to access the data
- Potential data sets
 - Property and tax data
 - Building permits and inspections
 - Code violations
 - Operating and capital budget
