Mat-Su Incident

➤ Attack

- Multi-pronged, multi-vectored, zero-day attack
- Probable method of delivery was email with hyperlink

➤ Impact

- Encrypted Windows servers, plus back-ups, phones, door lock system
- Impacted property, financial, email and most other systems
- Some data unrecoverable

➤ Current Status

- Re-imaged over 500 machines & re-programmed phones at 46 sites
- Restored property and financial system to external web service
- Re-designed and building new domain, network and servers
- Re-implementing over 60 apps with data recovered
